



## **Community Nursing Service Level Alliance Team**

### **Meeting summary 10 Dec 2014**

The main focus for the meeting on the 10<sup>th</sup> December was stakeholder engagement, particularly patient engagement and the best way to achieve this. The group agreed to focus initially on gathering feedback from patients who receive services in their homes. A format was agreed for patients to feedback on their experience of current services and the potential for service improvement.

For health professionals, there will be opportunities to provide input to the planning process in a few ways. We will host two open forums during February 2015 - one in the Eastern Bay of Plenty and one in the Western Bay of Plenty. Dates will be confirmed. In addition, other group-specific workshops will be scheduled during February and March. We are also working on a way for stakeholders to provide feedback electronically.

The SLAT received an excellent paper, prepared for the purposes of this work, on other relevant exemplar community and district nursing models around New Zealand and elsewhere.

We are continuing to gather information on the range of community nursing services currently available.
