During the last two meetings the SLAT received feedback from members' site visits to Hastings and Whakatane and discussed their findings. All the planned site visits are now completed and written reports are being collated. These will be made available to interested people, as with previous site visit reports.

We identified a need for further information on current referral processes and which is now being collated.

The SLAT is pleased to be receiving some patient feedback through the survey brochure. So far, feedback has been very positive about the services.
