

Integrated Community Nursing Implementation The Working Group Meeting update 09 Nov 2015

The second meeting of the Working Group established to provide advice and expertise to inform the development of an implementation plan for the Model of Care was held on 09 November. All members of the Working Group are now confirmed and they have a good understanding of the Model of Care and are clear on the Working Group's purpose and deliverables.

Based on the components of the Model of Care; the Working Group agreed to plan for implementation planning activities into manageable work stream activities. This will enable the Working Group to take lead in areas of their expertise, co-opt members as required to expedite the work.

The Working Group agreed to establish the following list of work stream areas.

1. Baseline information;
2. Community care coordination;
3. Initial care service delivery design;
4. Short term care service delivery design;
5. Routine continuing care service delivery design;
6. Complex continuing care service delivery design;
7. Application of Whānau Ora practices to the Model of Care;
8. Workforce practices;
9. Information and technology support;
10. Funding, performance and measurements;
11. Communication and engagement.

The focus of the meeting was on discussing the 11 draft work stream descriptors including scope, deliverables, dependencies, potential change impact and resource requirements.

The Working Group agreed that the Model of Care was beneficial to the patients and has formed a collective view of the challenging implementation planning work.

The next meeting will be held on Monday 23rd November. The agenda for this meeting will include further work to confirm work stream deliverables and an overarching draft work plan.
