



## **Integrated Community Nursing Implementation The Working Group Meeting update 09 Dec 2015**

The fourth meeting of the Working Group established to provide advice and expertise to inform the development of an implementation plan for the Model of Care was held on the 09<sup>th</sup> of December.

The Working Group agreed that Whanau Ora approach underpins the Model of Care and therefore it is a philosophy of care that should be applied across all of the work stream activities of this project. It was agreed that while there will be a specific focus to this work, the application of Whanau Ora practices should be the responsibility of the Working Group and not a sub-group. The members agreed to identify a common set of principles that will guide the implementation planning framework. It was also agreed that all members should complete the Whanau Tu Whanau Ora training.

Further work on the draft road map for implementation planning has been completed and two of the work streams have commenced activities. A calendar with planned activities for next year (2016) has been developed and the first face to face workshop is confirmed to take place in late January. The Working Group also confirmed the lead facilitators for each of the work stream and agreed the approach to co-opting members where there was a knowledge or experience gap.

The Working Group received an update on the District Nursing casemix tool developed by Canterbury District Health Board and agreed to collect further information on this.

The next meeting will be held on Wednesday 13th of January 2016. The agenda for this meeting will include planning for workshop, reablement approach to short term care delivery and Whanau Ora practices.
