POLICY STATEMENT

- It is Bay of Plenty District Health Board's (BOPDHB) policy to implement a vehicle control and parking allocation programme to meet professional and ethical responsibilities.
- To ensure patients / clients of BOPDHB have the best possible access to health and disability services, while ensuring safety and meeting the operational needs of staff and emergency services.

PURPOSE

- To ensure an orderly and safe allocation of limited parking resources.
- To maintain clear, immediate access for emergency service vehicles.
- To meet specific contractual obligations relating to the provision of parking (e.g. MRI, Ortholab, MedLab, Guild & Spence).
- To meet our obligations under the Health & Safety in Employment Act 1992.
