## CLEAN WALLS IN PUBLIC AREAS

### POLICY STATEMENT

Bay of Plenty District Health Board (BOPDHB) has a clean wall policy for all public areas within DHB facilities. No item will be displayed or placed in a public area without the consent of the Hospital Arts Committee, if it is Art or Taonga, or Property Services if it does not fall within the category of Art or Taonga.

### PURPOSE

- To create an environment that is clutter free, restful and aesthetically pleasing.
- To assist staff with the placement of art work / Taonga / notices
- To ensure that all art work goes before the Art Committee prior to placement on walls within BOPDHB.
- To ensure that the placement of Taonga is made in consultation with a Maori representatives from the Art Committee.
- To ensure that only appropriate information is displayed on notice boards in public areas

### EXCLUSIONS

- Any clinical area in which the primary clients are children
- Any approved Health and Safety signage: Signage content to be approved by the Manager, Employee Health and Safety and placement by Property Services.
- Any approved health service notices contained within clinical areas: Notice content to be approved by relevant manager and placement by Property Services.
- Notices placed on public notice boards
- Statutory Signage
